The nursery is part of Whinmoor St Paul's school family and is situated in a classroom with its own entrance and fantastic outside area.

We are open from 8.45am until 3.15pm during term time weekdays and offer flexible day (8.45 – 3.15), morning (8.45-11.45) and afternoon (12.15 – 3.15) sessions.



All children aged 3 and above are eligible for 15 hours funding, extra hours can be arranged at a cost of £4.00 per hour.

Our facilities include, a well resourced classroom, dedicated outside area with a playground and a nature zone.
