They will write their opinions on the texts and use their own experiences to write different versions of characters and events.

Science

They will group and classify using secondary sources and work scientifically by making careful observations.

COMPUTING: Introduction to Modelling.



Maths

Number & Place Value

Children will focus on counting forwards and backwards, beginning with 0, 1 or any given number. They will practise reading and writing numbers in numerals and words. Children will focus on identifying one more and one less of a given number.

Children will develop these skills by identifying and representing numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line, and using the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most and least.

Geography

Weather Patterns

Children will identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the UK and the location of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and North and South Poles.

PE

Ball skills and games – Children will develop their special awareness and coordination using a variety of ball skills. This will include dribbling, kicking, rolling throwing as well as using various equipment. This term PE will usually be on Tuesday afternoon and Friday Morning.
