The children should develop positive attitudes towards and stamina for writing

by:

- Reading and writing stories – with a focus on character description and familiar settings
- Reading, composing and performing poetry
- Reading and writing a set of instructions with a focus on, 'George's Marvellous Medicine,' by Roald Dahl.

Spelling: Word lists are sent out each week, to be practiced at home ready for a test on a Monday.



Science

Power of Forces

During this topic the children will identify that magnets attract some materials and not others and that these are known as magnetic materials. They will learn that some metals, but not all, are magnetic and that all nonmetals are non-magnetic. They will learn that magnets have two poles and that two magnets will attract or repel each other, depending on which poles are facing.

Maths

This term we will be learning to:

- Count from 0 in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100; find 10 or 100 more or less than a given number
- recognise the place value of each digit in a three-digit number (hundreds, tens and ones)
- compare and order numbers from up to 1000
- Identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations
- Read and write numbers up to 1000 in numerals and in words
- Solve number problems and practical problems involving these ideas

History and Geography
