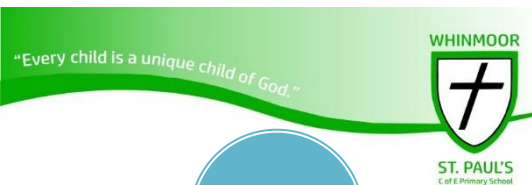
## PE
