The children in Year 6 have really enjoyed learning about the Romans this term. To reward them for all their hard work, we would love to treat them to a full day out at the Royal Armouries, where they will take part in a workshop on Boudicca's revolt.

With many thousands of fascinating objects and amazing handling collections the Royal Armouries is a great day out. We plan to spend the morning exploring the galleries and sketching the artefacts. Then in the afternoon, we will be transformed into Iceni warriors to re-live the drama of Boudicca's rebellion via an immersive, hands-on storytelling session led by a member of the famous tribe. We will be put through our paces by the disciplined Titus the Centurion to see if we have the strength, power and pride to make it in the Roman Army in an interactive, high-energy military drill.
