

## English

### **Reading:**

Children will be getting regular practice of reading texts that are equivalent in challenge to those presented by the SATs so that they are not disconcerted by the level of challenge. We will give children opportunities to answer questions in pairs - rather than in silence and on their own - a collaborative approach is best. In their collaborative working groups, children will work to create perfect answers.

We will help them distinguish the difference between answers worthy of 1, 2 or 3 marks.


