<p>Can you roll a dice and count the spots. Then identify the number that is one more and go on a 'number hunt' for that number. For example, number 6 on a clock. If you do not have a dice you could draw spots on cards to choose. This way you could work with numbers beyond 6 if you feel confident with numbers up to 6.</p> <p>Listen to a story and talk about what you have heard. What did you like? What made it interesting? Can you find any of our tricky words in it?</p>	<p>Practise counting up to 20. This can be done through playing hide and seek, singing number songs, chanting, or board games.</p> <p>Practice reading and writing the Phase 3 tricky words – was, all, they my Can you use each of these words in a sentence? Can you try to write a sentence with any of your tricky words?</p>	<p>Login and read a book on Oxford Owl. Try to complete one of the activities linked to the book. If you need any support with which level Tapestry me and I'll respond asap.</p> <p>Write the numbers 1 – 10 on individual pieces of paper. Ask an adult to hide them around the room, house or garden. Can you find all the numbers and then place them in the correct order. If you are super confident try numbers to 20.</p>	<p>Story sequencing challenge. Look at the 4 pictures. Sequence them to make a story. Can you tell someone your story? Try to making it as descriptive as you can. Once you have finished it, can you take a photograph and put it on Tapestry for your teachers to see?
