Play the Double Decker School Bus Game with someone in your house. Roll the dice and move forward the correct number of spaces. You can only stay on your spot if you can work out the double sum.	Play bunny ears. Ask a grown up to say a number from 1 to 5 and you have to show that number using the fingers on one hand. Then they will say 'double it' and you have to double your number using the other hand as fast as possible. Can you record all the doubles you have made in your home working book?	Play dominoes with someone in your house. You may need someone to teach you how to play. Can you find all the double dominoes? Then look at how you make doubles as you put the dominoes together while playing.
