<p>Phase 4 writing challenge. Can you use your phonics to write the word for each picture and then colour only the pictures that have the 'br' beginning sound.</p> <p>Use your knowledge of doubling to answer the doubling word problems. Use practical resources to support you in working out the answers.</p> <p>Watch Numberblocks episode Sixteen</p>	<p>Reading comprehension activity found in the resources pack. <i>(If they get stuck encourage the children to sound out each word and blend them to read)</i></p> <p>Teddy bear picnic sharing into 2 equal groups. Give each teddy bear one item at a time until all the items have gone. Does each bear have the same number of items?</p> <p>Watch Numberblocks episode Seventeen</p>	<p>Discuss the picture with a grown-up at home. Ask them to read the prompt questions to support your discussion. Try to use as much detail as you can. Think about all the different describing words you can use.</p> <p>Feeding Mini beasts sharing activity. Carefully give each mini beast one leaf at a time to make sure you share them fairly and equally.</p> <p>Watch Numberblocks episode Eighteen</p>	<p>Use the discussion you had yesterday about the picture to support you to write some simple sentences about the picture. Use your phonics mat and the tricky words to support your work.</p> <p>Sharing word problems. Use a selection of loose items to practically work out the answers to these sharing problems.</p> <p>Watch Numberblocks episode Nineteen</p>	<p>Complete the rhyming challenge activity. Read each of the animal names and then match each of the words to the rhyming animal name.</p> <p>Maths activity mat. Try to complete each of the challenges independently.
