Take a penny walk. Go for a walk with an adult and each time you come to a junction throw the penny up and watch it land. If it comes up heads you go left, or if it's tails turn right. You can either keep going until you get back to where you started or set yourself a time the head home. Upload to tapestry if you can.	Pick a couple of the science explorer activities in the documents section. Can you have a go at being an explorer and complete the tasks? Please take some pictures and upload to Tapestry if you can.	Play cross step outside: Chalk 6 squares by 6 squares. Choose a square each to stand in. Move to a new square either, left, right forward or back but NOT diagonally. When you move, put a cross in the square you were in before. The only rule is, you can't step into a square already crossed out. When a player finds themselves at a 'dead end,' they are out!	Can you practise pencil control? Are you able to do some straight lines, circles, zig-zag, wavy and spirals? Can you use lots of different colours and make some patterns? If you are feeling confident can you cut around the spirals to make something you can hang down? Upload to Tapestry if you can.	Make a picnic with an adult. See if you can include savoury and sweet food. Will you have sausage rolls? Chapatis? Sandwiches? What about a home-made ice lolly? Fruit? Buns? Enjoy your picnic outside. Upload some photos to Tapestry if you can.
