As we approach the end of week 2 of full school opening, thank you to those who continue to support us by bringing their children on time, following social distancing guidelines and collecting on time. It is imperative that we all follow the guidelines and continue to do all in our power to keep our school and community safe at all times.

Outside of school, we ask all families to follow the government rule of six, to further protect the community. If anyone in your family does test positive, we ask that you ring us and follow all isolation guidelines to the letter.

The NHS continue to list the following symptoms as main indicators of Covid. If you or your children show any of these signs, we ask that you do not come into school and follow medical advice with regard to testing and isolation.

- **a high temperature** –you feel hot to touch on your chest or back
- **a new, continuous cough** – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it could be worse than usual)
- **a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste**

We ask that those who have not returned their green data collection form to do so immediately. It is vital we have up to date details of your contacts, phone numbers and email address. .
