English

<u>Writing</u>-this term Year 1 will be diving into 'Farmer Dan' by Rod Simpson. Our focus this term is sentence structure and letter formation.

Children will also be exploring 'Superworm' by Julia Donaldson. Our main focus will be sentence rules, making sure our sentences start with a capital letter and ends with a full stop as well as looking at adjectives. Children will write their own character descriptions to describe the super worm.

<u>Reading</u> — Our class novel this term is The Lion Inside by Rachel Bright.

Maths

This term Year 1 will be learning to:

- Count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number
- Count, read and write numbers to 100 in numerals
- Count in multiples of twos, fives and tens
- Identify one more and one less.
- Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line
- Use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least
- Read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words.

KIRF- I can read and write numerals to 10.

Geography

Our World - Children will identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the UK and locate hot and cold areas of the world, in relation to the Equator and North and South Poles. They will explore the question, "Why can't Meerkats live in the North Pole?"



Science

The Human Body- Children will learn to: -

- Identify the five senses and associated body parts:
- o Sight: eyes
- o Hearing: ears
- o Smell: nose
- o Taste: tongue
- o Touch: skin
- Review the importance of taking care of your body: exercise, cleanliness, healthy foods and rest.
