### Keeping Safe and Managing Risk

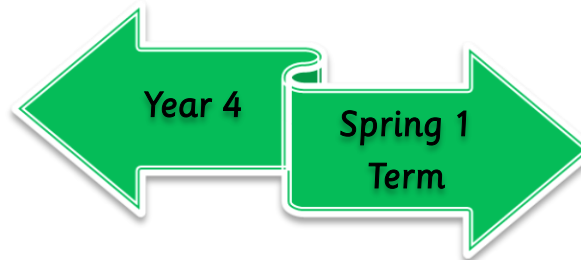
- Children will understand the importance to stay safe online, with a focus on media violence and gaming.
