English

This half term we will be working on improving the content of our writing, focusing on the use of grammar within sentences as well as improving our writing with a range of punctuation and vocabulary.

We will write persuasive letters from a Suffragette to a local MP, looking at factual information to support our understanding of the late 18th Century and the early 19th Century Britian. We will also develop a balanced argument based on humans use of palm oil.

Our Whole Class Reading text this half term is Cogheart by Peter Bunzl. The story sees a young Lily Hartman, a strong-willed girl, who felt trapped in a life of Victorian stuffiness at her prim boarding school. But after her father-a famous inventor-disappears on a routine zeppelin flight, Lily's life gets turned upside down.

This term Year 6 will continue to go back in time to discover what life was like in Victorian Britian.


We will continue to spend time looking at what life was like for Victorian children, looking at what their leisure times were like, education and lifestyles.
