

## English

### Writing

This term year 4 will be delving into the novel "Tutankhamun" and write a newspaper report of the discovery of Tutankhamun by Howard Carter and his team. They will also write instructions on mummification, using inspiration from our class novel and our school trip.

Year 4 will continue with daily handwriting practise, with a focus on joining up their letters.

### Reading

Our class novel this term is:

- Tutankhamun – They will uncover the true story of an Egyptian King, and the 20<sup>th</sup> century explorer who found him.

## Maths

This term year 4 will be learning about:

- **Decimals**
- **Money**
- **Time**

Year 4 will practise their times tables daily in class, ready for their test in June.

Children should practise these at home as well as **Multiplication Timetable Check (MTC)** on MathShed.

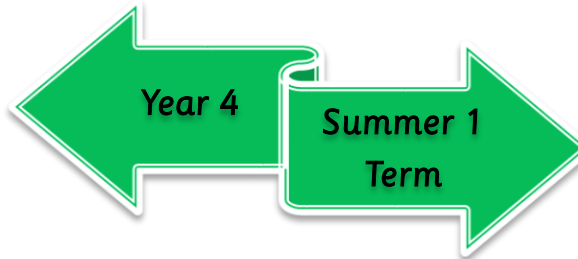
### **KIRF- 1 to 12 times table**

## History:

- Children will explore the question, "How can we discover the world of Ancient Egypt?"

Children will investigate different aspects of Ancient Egypt, including learning about the Gods, writing, number as well as Tutankhamun and Cleopatra. They will start this topic, with an Ancient Egyptian workshop at Leeds Museum.
