Writing

This term year 4 will be delving into the novel "Cinderella and the Nile". They will develop skills of inference before exploring the author's use of literary language and the effect that this has on the reader. They will explore character feeling within diary writing, before writing their own traditional tale with a twist.

Year 4 will continue with daily handwriting practise, with a focus on joining up their letters with consistent letter height.

Reading

Our class novel this term is:

- Cinderella and the Nile – They will read a traditional tale with a twist.

Maths

This term year 4 will be learning about:

Year 4 will practise their times tables daily in class, ready for their test mid-June. Children should practise these at home as well as **Multiplication Timetable Check (MTC)** on MathShed.

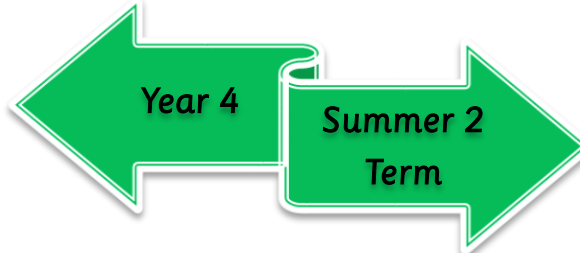
KIRF- Fractions
