Care

Link to Bible story e.g.
The Good Samaritan (Luke 10:25-37)

Possible Bible stories and key message:

- **The Good Samaritan** [Luke 10:25-37](#) - Love thy neighbour as yourself - We show care by helping others and taking responsibility
- **Creation story** [Genesis 1:1-2:3](#), - God gave humans the responsibility of caring for the earth.
- **Jesus Heals the Ten Lepers** [Luke 17:11-19](#) - Jesus showing care for others by healing them.
- **Jesus and the Children** [Matthew 19:13-14](#), [Mark 10:13-16](#), [and Luke 18:15-17](#) - Jesus shows that he cares for all people, including children.

Kindness

Possible Bible stories and key message:

- **Jesus Heals the Ten Lepers** **Luke 17:11-19** - Jesus shows kindness to others, even when the community doesn't.
- **Christmas Story** - God sent His son to save the world. Kindness of strangers when visiting Jesus.
- **Good Samaritan** **Luke 10:25-37**- A stranger shows kindness.
- **The Story of Ruth** **Book of Ruth (Old Testament)**- Loyalty, generosity, and kindness that strengthens family ties and provides support through hardship.
- **The people of Malta** **Acts 28:1-9**, - Hospitality and generosity to strangers in desperate need, even when it strains their own resources.

Compassion

Possible Bible stories and key message:

- **David's Kindness to Mephibosheth** [2 Samuel 9:7](#) - A lifelong commitment to showing grace, compassion, and generosity to someone from a defeated house.
- **Feeding the Five Thousand** [Matthew 14:13-21](#) - Compassion involves recognizing and addressing the needs of others, even when you are experiencing your own difficulties.
- **Jesus heals the Ten Lepers** [Mark 1:40-42](#) - Compassion can mean breaking social barriers to show love and care for those who are on the outside.
- **Jesus raises the widow of Nain's son** [Luke 7:11-15](#) - Compassion is about deeply feeling for others in their sorrow and taking action to comfort and restore them.

Peace

Possible Bible stories and key message:

- **Jesus Calms the Storm** [Luke 8:22-25](#)- This story shows that Jesus can bring peace to even the most overwhelming circumstances when we respond with faith instead of fear.
- **Prophecies of the "Prince of Peace"** [Isaiah 9:6-7](#) - This highlights Jesus as the ultimate source of peace, both peace with God and peace among people.
- **Palm Sunday** - The story of Palm Sunday is linked to the value of peace because the people celebrated Jesus as a bringer of peace.
- **Jesus's last words to his disciples** [John 14:27](#)- Jesus offers a special kind of peace that is not like the world's.

Generosity

Possible Bible stories and key message:

- **The feeding of the Five Thousand** **Matthew 14:13-21**- The story highlights God's abundant provision and the generosity of sharing what little you have.
- **Zacchaeus the Tax Collector** **Luke 19:1-10** - When Zacchaeus met Jesus, he was so transformed that he pledged to give half of his belongings to the poor and repay those he had cheated four times what he owed them.
- **The Story of Ruth** - Loyalty, generosity, and kindness that strengthens family ties and provides support through hardship.
- **The Widow's Mite** **Mark 12:41-44** Jesus pointed out the generosity of a poor widow who gave her last two small coins, which was more than the rich people who gave large amounts but still had plenty left.

Friendship

Possible Bible Stories and key message:

- ▶ **David and Jonathan 1 Samuel**- Jonathan, the son of King Saul, and David forge a powerful and loyal friendship that lasts even when Saul becomes jealous and tries to harm David.
- ▶ **Ruth and Naomi Ruth 1:16-17** - After her husband dies, Ruth chooses to stay with her mother-in-law Naomi, showing deep loyalty and commitment even when Naomi urges her to return to her own people.
- ▶ **The Paralytic Lowered Through the Roof Mark 2:1-12, Luke 5:17-26 or Matthew 9:1-8** - When Jesus is teaching, a paralyzed man is unable to get close enough to hear him, so his four friends lower him through a hole in the roof to get him to Jesus.
