By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts **instantly**.

Children should be able to say the days of the week in order and be able to say the next day.

E.g. Today is Tuesday.

What day will it be tomorrow?

Top Tips

The secret to success is practicing **little** and **often**. Use time wisely. Can you practice these KIRFs while walking to school or during a car journey? You do not need to practice them all at once; perhaps you could have a fact of the day. If you would like more ideas, please speak to your child's teacher.

Use Practical Resources -

- Read the 'Hungry Caterpillar'
- Ask your child each day 'What day is it today?' 'What day will it be tomorrow?'
- Use alliteration e.g. monkey Monday, tiger Tuesday, whale Wednesday, thornbill Thursday, froggy Friday, squirrel Saturday and snail Sunday. Make it fun by asking them to pretend to be the animal.
